Sewer Construction

Chatham – C.C. Construction, Inc. will continue work for the Phase 1D-2A: Route 137 – Morton Road Sewer Extension Project (1D-2A) and for the Queen Anne Pumping Station (QAPS) Upgrade as outlined below. N&M Excavating LLC will continue work for the Crowell Road Phase 2 & Chatham Fish Pier Infrastructure Project (Crowell Road Phase 2 & CFP) as outlined below.

Work for the week of February 13th – February 17th:

1D-2A:

- Continued sewer work on Meetinghouse Road 2/13 – 2/15, work is progressing north from the Rt. 28 intersection. *Detour utilizing Morton Road in place. Traffic heading to Commerce Park to be accessed by Main Street.*
- Sewer work expected to commence on Middle Road 2/15 or 2/16. *Detour utilizing Morton Road in place. Traffic heading to Commerce Park to be accessed by Main Street.*
- Tentative site work at Pump Station #3 (Meetinghouse Road).

Crowell Road Phase 2 and CFP:

- No work expected.

QAPS:

- Site work at pump station site expected (40 Queen Anne Road; SE corner of Queen Anne Road and Oyster Pond Furlong). **On 2/16, multiple detours expected to be in place as follows, signage and police details will be in place to assist motorists:**
 - *Traffic from Absegami Run and Oyster Pond Furlong will be routed through Chatham Village Market/CVS back entrance.*
 - *Queen Anne Road will be closed at the intersection of Queen Anne Road, Main Street, and Depot Road. Traffic will be routed to Main Street to the rotary.*
 - *Queen Anne Road will be closed starting at the intersection of Oyster Pond Lane, Queen Anne Road, and Adams Lane. Traffic will be routed up Adams Lane to Main Street.*

Two Week Look Ahead (2/20 – 2/24):

1D-2A:

- Continued sewer work expected on Middle Road. *Traffic plan to be determined.*
- Sewer work on the Bike Path expected to commence, work will start from Meetinghouse Road and proceed east toward the Chatham WPCF. *Police detail(s) will be on-site to assist users of the bike path through the immediate area(s) of construction.*
- Tentative site work at Pump Station #3 (Meetinghouse Road).

Crowell Road Phase 2 and CFP:

- No work expected.

QAPS:

- Site work at pump station site expected (40 Queen Anne Road; SE corner of Queen Anne Road and Oyster Pond Furlong). *Police detail(s) as needed to facilitate traffic and assist motorists.*

Three Week Look Ahead (2/27 – 3/3):

1D-2A:

- Continued sewer work expected on Middle Road. *Traffic plan to be determined.*
- Continued sewer work expected on the Bike Path, work will start from Meetinghouse Road and proceed toward the Chatham WWTF. *Police detail(s) will be on-site to assist users of the bike path through the immediate area of construction.*
- Tentative site work at Pump Station #3 (Meetinghouse Road).

Crowell Road Phase 2 and CFP:

- Work area to be determined.

QAPS:

- Site work at pump station site expected (40 Queen Anne Road; SE corner of Queen Anne Road and Oyster Pond Furlong). *Police detail(s) as needed to facilitate traffic and assist motorists.*

Please note that this is a projected schedule and will be adjusted accordingly based on the Contractor's actual progress and the weather.

Roads will be passable at the end of each day. Police Details and Contractors will work with residents to ensure their needs for access are addressed.

Police Details and signage will be in-place to assist motorists in reaching their destination.

Normal work hours are 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM Monday to Friday, weather permitting, unless otherwise noted.
