Sewer Construction Update

Chatham – C.C. Construction, Inc. will be continuing work for the Phase 1D-2A: Route 137 – Morton Road Sewer Extension Project (1D-2A) and for the Queen Anne Pumping Station (QAPS) Upgrade as outlined below. N&M Excavating LLC will be continuing work for the Crowell Road Phase 2 & Chatham Fish Pier Infrastructure Project (Crowell Road Phase 2 & CFP) as outlined below.

Work for the week of May 15th – May 19th:

1D-2A:

- Commence sewer lateral work on Morton Road. *Police detail(s) will be in place to assist motorists.*
- Sewer testing planned for Meetinghouse Road on Monday, 5/15 and Mill Hill Road on Tuesday, 5/16. Tentative testing for Meetinghouse Road expected to continue Wednesday, 5/17 through Friday, 5/19. *Police details will be in place in the vicinity of the testing to assist motorists.*
- On Thursday, 5/18 work is planned for fine grading in preparation of paving on Mill Hill Road. On Friday, 5/19 a binder course of pavement is planned to be installed on Mill Hill Road. Expect delays on Thursday, 5/18. *Traffic limited to one lane alternating traffic.*
- Site work at Pump Station #3 expected (Meetinghouse Road).

Crowell Road Phase 2 and CFP:

- No work planned.

QAPS:

- Sewer work expected near the vicinity of the pump station site (40 Queen Anne Road; south side of Queen Anne Road and Oyster Pond Furlong intersection). ***Multiple detours expected to be in place Monday through Friday as follows, signage and police details will be in place to assist motorists:***
 - ***Traffic from Absegami Run and Oyster Pond Furlong will be route through Chatham Village Market/CVS back entrance.***
 - ***Queen Anne Road will be closed at the intersection of Queen Anne Road, Main Street, and Depot Road. Traffic will be routed to Main Street to the rotary.***
 - ***Queen Anne Road will be closed starting at the intersection of Oyster Pond Lane, Queen Anne Road, and Adams Lane. Traffic will be routed up Adams Lane to Main Street.***

**Two Week Look Ahead (5/22 – 5/26): Road work expected to end by noon on Friday, 5/26
1D-2A:**

- Continue sewer lateral work on Morton Road. ***Police detail(s) will be in place to assist motorists.***
- Tentative site work at Pump Station #3 expected (Meetinghouse Road).

Crowell Road Phase 2 and CFP:

- No work planned.

QAPS:

- Site work expected at pump station site (40 Queen Anne Road; south side of Queen Anne Road and Oyster Pond Furlong intersection).

QAPS:

- Site work expected at pump station site (40 Queen Anne Road; south side of Queen Anne Road and Oyster Pond Furlong intersection).

Please note that this is a projected schedule and will be adjusted accordingly based on the Contractor's actual progress and the weather.

Roads will be passable at the end of each day. Police Details and Contractors will work with residents to ensure their needs for access are addressed.

Police Details and signage will be in-place to assist motorists in reaching their destination.

Normal work hours are 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM Monday to Friday, weather permitting, unless otherwise noted.
