Sewer Construction Update

Chatham – C.C. Construction, Inc. will be continuing work for the Phase 1D-2A: Route 137 – Morton Road Sewer Extension Project (1D-2A) and the Queen Anne Pumping Station (QAPS) Upgrade. Dig It Construction LLC will be continuing work on the Phase 1E-2 – Stage Harbor Road Sewer Extension Project (1E-2) and Robert B. Our Co., Inc. will be commencing work on the Mill Pond Pumping Station Upgrade (MPPS) as outlined below.

1D-2A:

- Continued site work at Pump Station #3 (Meetinghouse Road) and Pump Station #4 (Twine Field Drive) is expected.

1E-2:

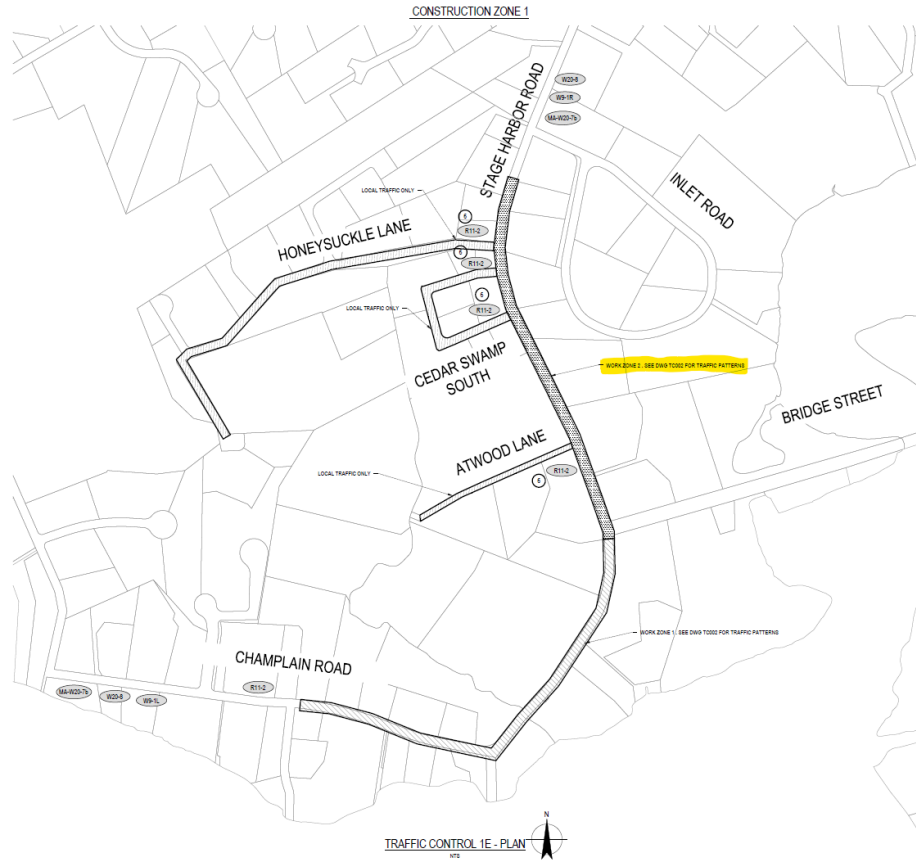
