### Sewer Construction Update

Chatham – C.C. Construction, Inc. will be continuing work for the Phase 1D-2A: Route 137 – Morton Road Sewer Extension Project (1D-2A) and the Queen Anne Pumping Station (QAPS) Upgrade. Dig It Construction LLC will be continuing work on the Phase 1E-2 – Stage Harbor Road Sewer Extension Project (1E-2) as outlined below.

Robert B. Our Co., Inc. will be commencing work on the Mill Pond Pumping Station Upgrade (MPPS) and C.C. Construction, Inc. will be commencing work on the Phase 1C-5 – Oyster Pond Sewer Extension (1C-5) this coming fall.

**\*\*Saturday June 8<sup>th</sup> and Sunday June 9<sup>th</sup> – Queen Anne Road (West end) – Road Closure\*\*:**

**QAPS:**

- ***For public safety reasons, a portion of the road will be closed in the vicinity of the pump station site (intersection of Queen Anne Road and Oyster Pond Furlong) will be closed for the weekend and a detour will be in place. Police detail(s) during the day, message boards, and signage will be on site to assist motorists and pedestrians in this area.***
  - ***Both lanes of traffic will be open for access to Oyster Pond Furlong.***
  - ***No through traffic onto Queen Anne Road from Rt. 28 – Main Street. Queen Anne Road will be open to Chatham Village Market and CVS customers ONLY.***
  - ***Local traffic on Queen Anne Road near the intersection of Pond Street will be detoured to the Downtown Chatham Rotary.***
  - ***Queen Anne Road northbound from Downtown Chatham Rotary and Pond Street will only be open to Oyster Pond Furlong. Local access only, no Thru-Traffic. Chatham Village Market and CVS shall only be accessible from Rt. 28 – Main Street.***

- *Queen Anne Inn and other local businesses South of Oyster Pond Furlong shall be accessed from the Downtown Chatham Rotary or Pond Street only.*

**Work for the week of June 10<sup>th</sup> – June 14<sup>th</sup>:**

**1D-2A:**

- Continued site work at Pump Station #3 (Meetinghouse Road) and Pump Station #4 (Twine Field Drive) is expected.

**QAPS:**

- Site work at the pump station site (40 Queen Anne Road; south side of Queen Anne Road and Oyster Pond Furlong intersection).
- *For public safety reasons, a portion of the road will be closed in the vicinity of the pump station site (intersection of Queen Anne Road and Oyster Pond Furlong) and a detour will be in place.   - *Queen Anne Inn and other local businesses South of Oyster Pond Furlong shall be accessed from the Downtown Chatham Rotary or Pond Street only.*

**1E-2:**

- Continued sewer work on Stage Harbor Road north of the Bridge Street intersection. *For public safety reasons, Stage Harbor Road between Bridge Street and Cedar Street will be closed and a detour will be in place.*

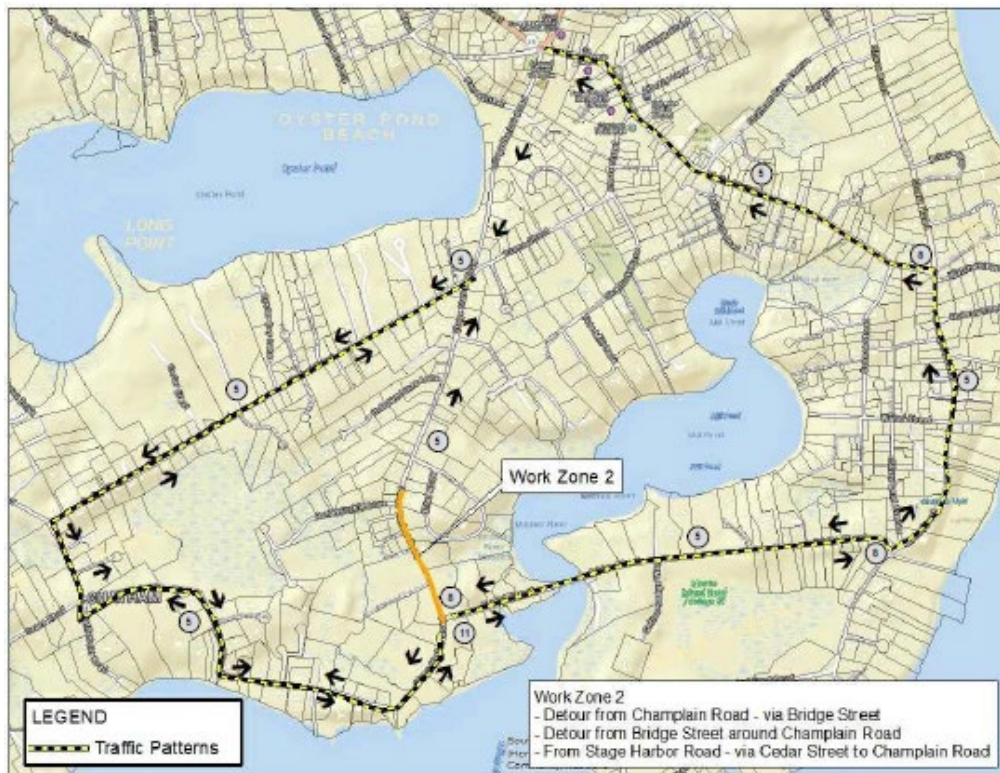
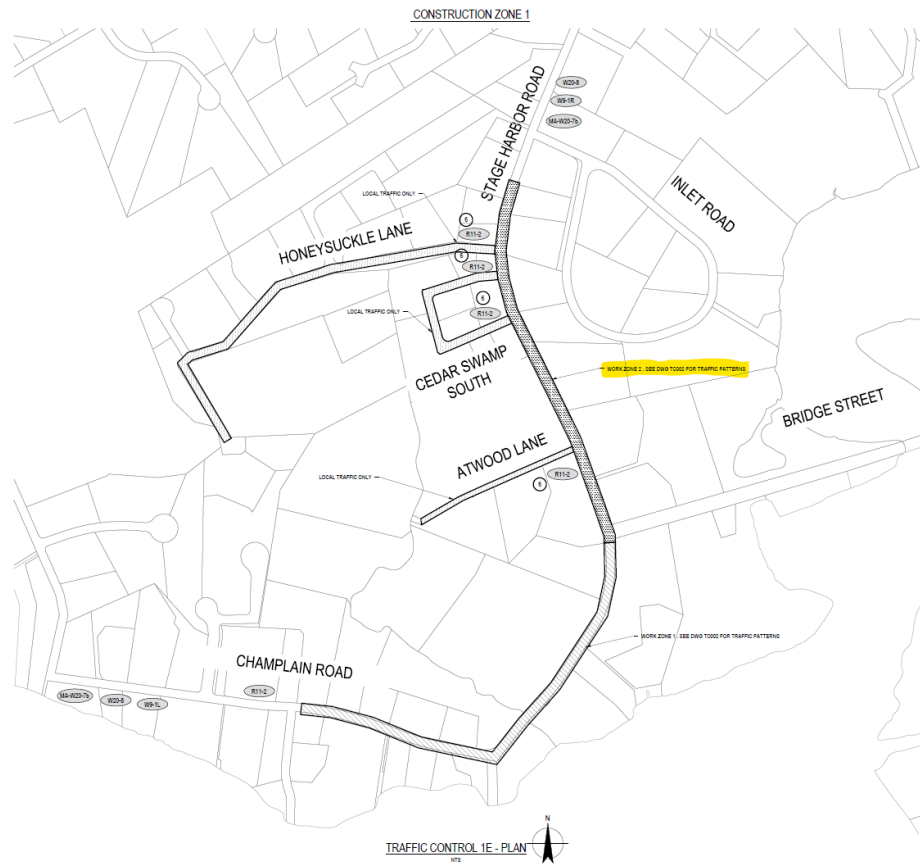
