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Sewer Construction Update

Chatham – C.C. Construction, Inc. will be continuing work for the Phase 1D-2A: Route 137 – Morton Road Sewer Extension Project (1D-2A), the Queen Anne Pumping Station (QAPS) Upgrade, and the Phase 1C-5 – Oyster Pond Sewer Extension (1C-5). Dig It Construction LLC will be continuing work on the Phase 1E-2 – Stage Harbor Road Sewer Extension Project (1E-2). Robert B. Our Co., Inc. will be continuing work on the Mill Pond Pumping Station Upgrade (MPPS) as outlined below.

Work for the week of October 28th – November 1st:

1D-2A:

- Continued site work at Pump Station #3 (Meetinghouse Road) and Pump Station #4 (Twine Field Drive) is expected.

QAPS:

- Continued site work at the pump station site is expected (40 Queen Anne Road; south side of Queen Anne Road and Oyster Pond Furlong intersection).
- Monday 10/28 - sidewalk work is expected near the pump station. ***For public safety reasons, the southbound lane of Queen Anne Road will be closed from the Chatham Village Market to the Oyster Pond Furlong intersection. Local traffic only but access may be limited depending on the construction. Police details and signage will be in place.***
- Tuesday 10/29 - final paving expected. ***For public safety reasons, both lanes are expected to be closed. Police detail(s) and signage will be in place.***

1E-2:

- Continued site work is expected at the pumping station site (Old Mill Boat Yard/Harbormasters Garage) and the Harbormaster's Office.

MPPS:

- Continued sewer work on Mill Pond Road. *Road closures are expected, local traffic only. Police detail(s) will be onsite to assist motorists.*
Please note that work associated with the Mill Pond Pumping Station will close access to the Town Landing

1C-5:

- Continued sewer work on Wood Carver Knoll is expected through mid-week. *Access will be limited; police detail(s) will be onsite to assist residents.*
- Commence sewer work on Pond View West is expected. *Access will be limited; police detail(s) will be onsite to assist residents.*

Two Week Look Ahead (11/4– 11/8):

1D-2A:

- Continued site work at Pump Station #3 (Meetinghouse Road) and Pump Station #4 (Twine Field Drive) is expected.

QAPS:

- No work planned.

1E-2:

- Continued site work is expected at the pumping station site (Old Mill Boat Yard/Harbormasters Garage).

MPPS:

- Continued sewer work on Mill Pond Road. *Road closures are expected, local traffic only. Police detail(s) will be onsite to assist motorists.*
Please note that work associated with the Mill Pond Pumping Station will close access to the Town Landing

1C-5:

- Continued sewer work in the Pond View neighborhood is expected. *Access will be limited; police detail(s) will be onsite to assist residents.*

Three Week Look Ahead (11/11 – 11/15):

1D-2A:

- Continued site work at Pump Station #3 (Meetinghouse Road) and Pump Station #4 (Twine Field Drive) is expected.

QAPS:

- No work planned.

1E-2:

- Continued site work is expected at the pumping station site (Old Mill Boat Yard/Harbormasters Garage).

MPPS:

- Continued sewer work on Mill Pond Road. *Road closures are expected, local traffic only. Police detail(s) will be onsite to assist motorists.*
Please note that work associated with the Mill Pond Pumping Station will close access to the Town Landing

1C-5:

- Continued sewer work in the Pond View neighborhood is expected. *Access will be limited; police detail(s) will be onsite to assist residents.*

Please note that this is a projected schedule and will be adjusted accordingly based on the Contractor's actual progress and the weather.

Roads will be passable at the end of each day. Police Details and Contractors will work with residents to ensure their needs for access are addressed.

Police Details and signage will be in-place to assist motorists in reaching their destination.

Normal work hours are 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM Monday to Friday, weather permitting, unless otherwise noted.
